All scholarship submissions require referee details from a teacher/contact at the applicant's primary school. Please ensure that correct details are given for this referee, as we may need to contact them regarding this submission.

Due date for this submission package is Friday 17th September, 2021. Please email, post or deliver the submission (with all evidence attached) into the school office by the due date. See below for contact details.

All applicants will be informed of their outcome. Successful applicants will receive a call from the school Finance Officer to organise payments.

Scholarships are open to any student entering Year 7 who can demonstrate strength and aptitude in **one** of the following areas:

- Academic Studies
- Sports
- Arts
- Community

The scholarship applicant process is as follows:

1. Applicants must have completed an enrolment interview with a staff member of BBSC in the first instance. At this interview expressions of interest in applying for a scholarship will be offered.
2. Applicants will then be contacted to forward a submission to support the application. The submission must include the following:

3. All applicants will be notified by mail of the success of their application.

Students awarded a Scholarship will have their progress reviewed in June/July each year. Students awarded a scholarship must continue to meet the behavioural and academic effort results as outlined in the scholarship expectations attached.

Year 7 Scholarship Value: \$250 per successful applicant. The scholarship funding can be used with the discretion of the parent/guardian for the following examples:

- School Resource Scheme
- Subject Levies
- Subject competition/s costs
- Sports registrations
- Hire of instruments
- Extra curricular activities

Once the scholarship has been awarded, the school Finance Officer will be the contact person for payments for relevant academic payments and support.

It will be at the College's discretion to award the number of scholarships offered each year. Only one scholarship will be awarded per student. Scholarships will only be offered on year 7 enrolments for the beginning of the school year. Scholarships will continue throughout Junior Secondary providing criteria and expectations are maintained.
