Buddy Out Process

Teacher uses **ESCM strategies** to encourage student to engage in class



Student continues to disrupt/be non-compliant <u>Signpost first warning</u>: "What are you doing?" "What should you be doing?" "What are you going to do?"

When a student leaves the room without teacher instruction and does not return – Forced Buddy Out - 'Away' on ID attend (Truancy detention given) – Purple sheet not required

Student disrupts again - Teacher says:

"You have chosen to leave the room"

Student sent to 'Buddy Out' Teacher with 'Buddy
Out' Sheet

Student goes to 'Buddy Out' teacher to complete 'Buddy Out' Sheet (Student is redirected back to teacher at end of lesson to finalise 'Buddy Out')

Signed 'Buddy Out' Sheet is sent to SSR ASAP

If student fails to attend BO room or return to teacher, please mark as 'Away' on ID attend (Truancy detention given)

Three Buddy Outs will result in referral to DP

Teacher to Oneschool incident, make a phone call to the parent and record contact

'Moving Forward' Sheet is completed before the next lesson and used to monitor success of the 1-3 goals over the next 3 lessons

The goals formulated on the 'Moving Forward'
Sheet are reviewed after 3 lessons and contact is
made with both student and parent

'Moving Forward' Sheet is submitted to HOD – Sent to SSR – HOD provides support / further consequence
