

Curriculum

- Senior student leaders are required to promote and role model sun safe behaviours to younger students
- Teachers/staff model sun safe behaviours such as wearing hats, applying sunscreen and wearing sunglasses

Uniform

- Students are actively encouraged to wear broad brimmed or bucket hats whenever they are outside
- Staff are encouraged and wear a hat or use an umbrella for outdoor activities, including playground duty

Sunscreen

- Students and staff are actively encouraged to supply SPF 30 (or higher) broad spectrum, water resistant sunscreen regularly
- Sunscreen is readily available at various points around the school campus and during camps

Sport and Physical Education

- Students are actively encouraged to wear broad brimmed or bucket hats for sport activities
- The school dress code includes shirts with collars and hats
- For outdoor carnivals, students are encouraged to wear a t-shirt
- Swimming carnivals are run indoors at external venue
- Use of portable shade structures for carnivals and all day events to provide sun safety

Camps and Excursions

- Sun protection is considered in the planning of all camps and excursions
- Planning of outdoor activities and excursions include the provision of shade areas
- Camps are run in Autumn, Spring and Winter when possible
