

## Dear Parent / Carer

Thank you for your interest in Brisbane Bayside State College's Junior Secondary Scholarship.

Scholarships are open to all students in years 7, 8 and 9 who can demonstrate strength and aptitude in <u>one</u> of the following areas:

- Academic
- Sports
- Arts
- Community

The scholarship value is determined each year to cover the cost of the Student Resource Scheme, however the scholarship funding can be used at the discretion of the parent/guardian for any school related expenditure. Year 6 students can apply for the scholarship in the year prior to commencing at BBSC. Year 7 and 8 students must apply by the due date for consideration for the following year. Students can apply for scholarships in a maximum of two areas, however only one scholarship will be awarded per student, and students must apply for the scholarship each year.
