Thank you for your interest and application regarding Brisbane Bayside State College's – Senior Schooling Bursary. The next step in our process is for the applicant to apply for a bursary (attached), with supporting evidence that demonstrates the applicant's strengths in their chosen areas.

In Senior Schooling, academic Bursaries are awarded to students based on their Semester 2 academic, effort and behaviour results across all subjects. Students must apply to receive these Bursaries.

There is also the opportunity for students to apply for a 'discretionary' senior schooling Bursary in either sporting, the arts or community areas.

The criterion for each of these Bursaries is included within this application package. Please ensure that the applicant provides evidence, which supports their selected area and demonstrates their strength and aptitude within this area.

All Bursary submissions require referee details from a teacher at the applicant's current high school. Please ensure that correct details are given for this referee, as we may need to contact them regarding this submission.

Due date for this application package is Friday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2022. Please email, post or deliver the submission (with all evidence attached) into the school office by the due date. See below for contact details.

All applicants will be informed of their outcome. Successful applicants will receive a call from the school Finance Officer to organise payments.

2. All applicants will be notified by mail of the success of their application.

Students awarded a Bursary will have their progress reviewed in June/July. Students awarded a Bursary must continue to meet the behavioural and academic effort results as outlined in the Bursary expectations attached.

Each year the Bursary Value is \$325 per successful applicant. The Bursary funding can be used at the discretion of the parent/guardian for the following examples:

- School Resource Scheme
- Subject Levies
- Subject competition/s costs
- Sports registrations
- Hire of instruments
- Extra curricula activities

Once a Bursary has been awarded, the school Finance Officer will be the contact person for relevant academic payments and support.

It will be at the College's discretion to award the number of bursaries offered each year up to a maximum of four per year level. Only one Bursary will be awarded per student.

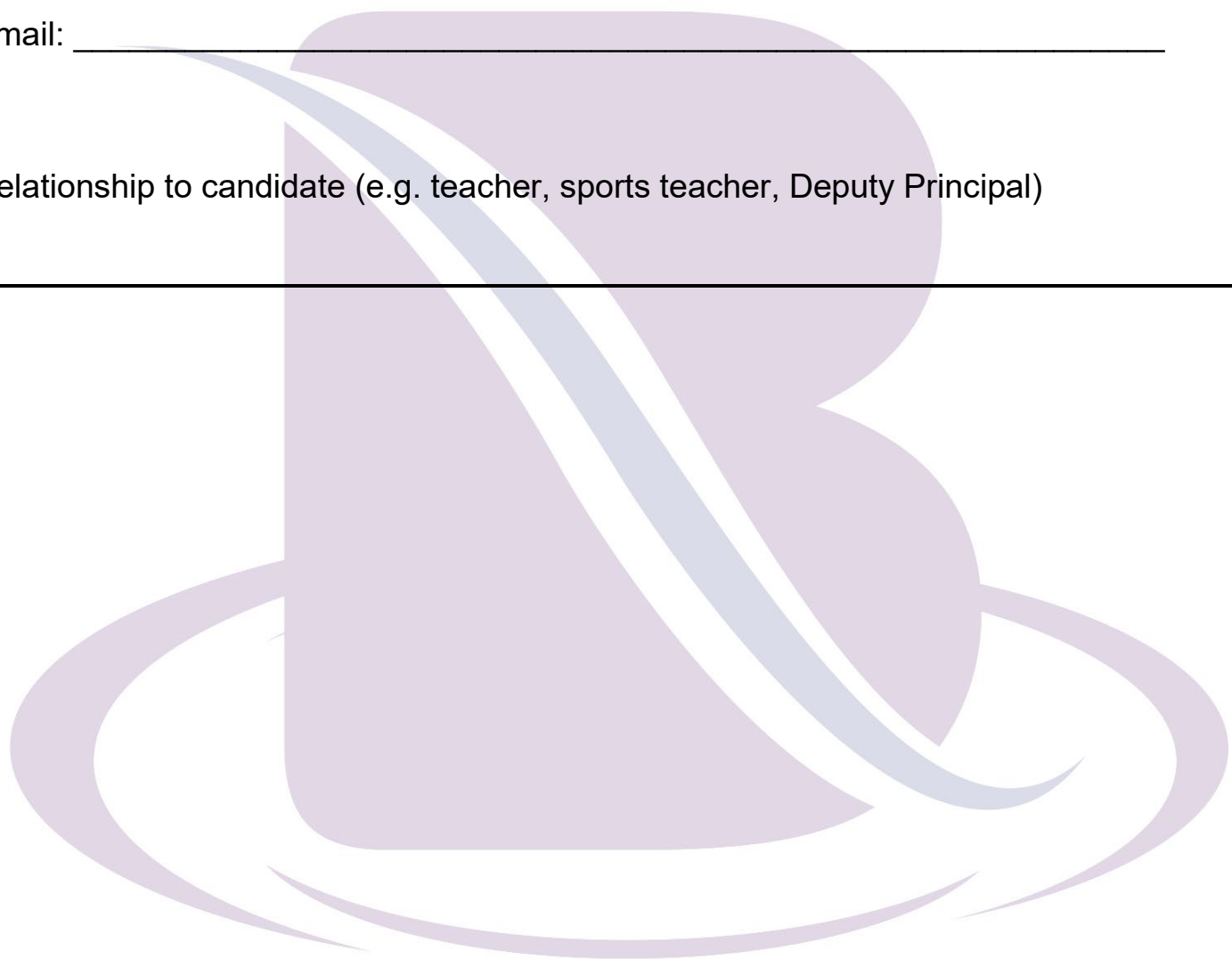

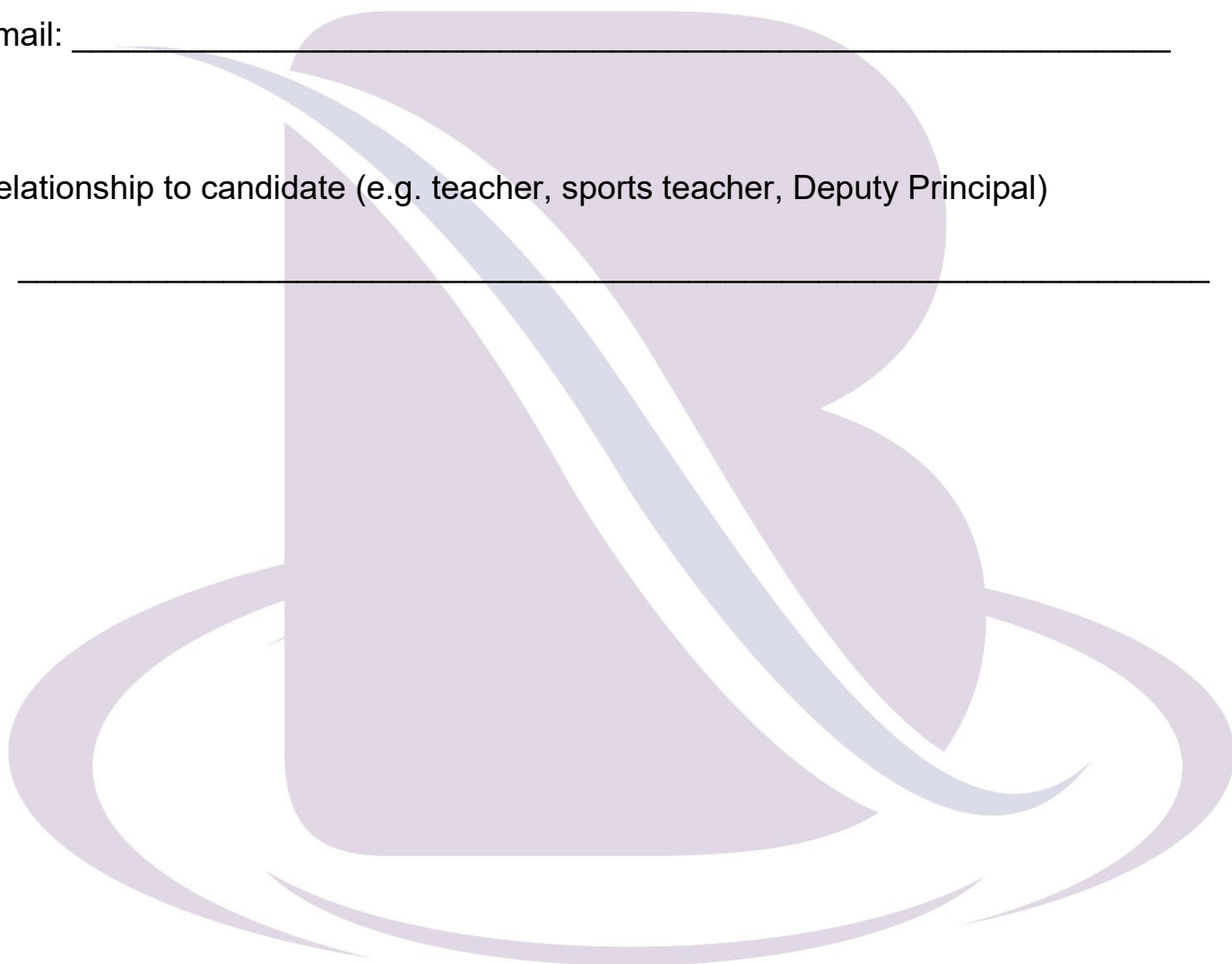

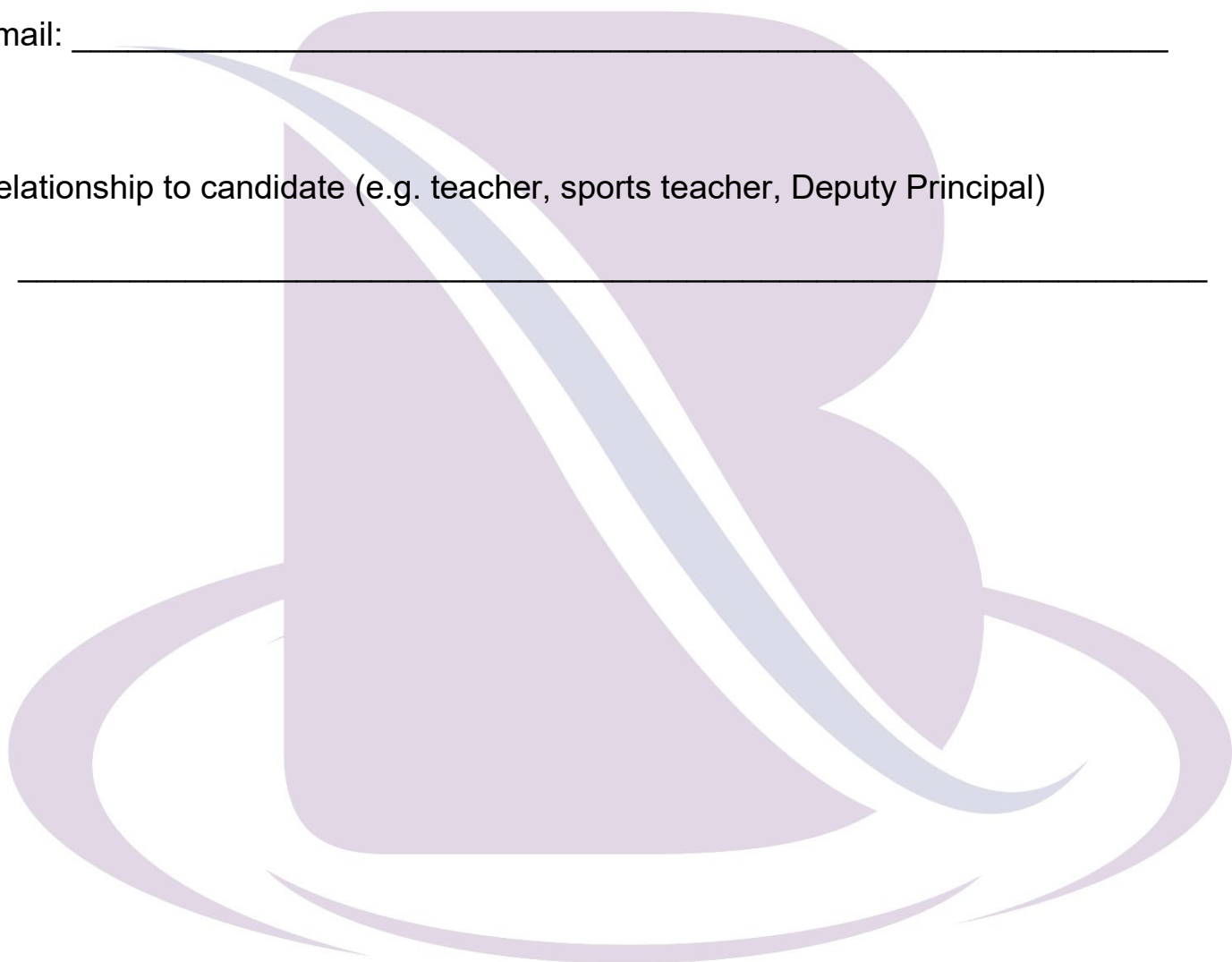
