Attendance at Invitation Only Events and Privileges

Participation in Senior School Events and Privileges is by 'invitation only'.

These events and privileges include:

- accessing home study during exam blocks, and Thursday afternoon lunch and session 4
- approved flexible study arrangements
- purchasing a senior jersey
- receiving a senior leader badge
- year 10 semi formal
- year 12 formal
- extra-curricular activities involving absences from class
- representing the school in a sporting teams/competitions and other interschool and intraschool events
- application for leadership roles and responsibilities such as peer mentor or year 12 leadership positions.

To be eligible for invitation to participate in these events and privileges, senior students at Brisbane Bayside State College are expected to demonstrate a self-motivated and mature approach to their studies, to be a role model, to uphold the expectations of all students and to understand and accept the school's Senior Statement of Expectations.

- Attend at a rate of 90% or higher unless there are extenuating circumstances which have been documented by satisfactory parent explanation or medical certificate; Student attendance levels are not affected when absences are supported by medical certificates or when students are engaged in external courses, SAT, work experience or other College approved activities. Class work and assessment completed to a satisfactory minimum standard.
- Complete class work, drafts, checkpoints and assessment by due dates to a satisfactory minimum standard as per the school's assessment policy on the school website.
- Complete detentions when scheduled.
- Behave to ensure that I am eligible to represent the school with no suspensions or major behaviour incidences in a school term where the "by invitation" event occurs.
- Present in a way that demonstrates respect for myself, my family and my school by wearing the correct uniform at all times in the way that it was designed to be worn.
- Continually work towards the successfully completion of my Senior Studies by achieving my QCE/QCIA for continuing their enrolment at Brisbane Bayside State College.

Senior Statement of Expectations Post Compulsory Studies

As a student who is completing or has completed the compulsory years of schooling, the provision of further secondary education at Brisbane Bayside State College is provided on the acceptance of, and adherence to, the conditions set by Education Queensland, the Queensland Curriculum & Assessment Authority, the behaviour expectations of school and School's Student Code of Conduct.
