



The *Student Dress Code* is endorsed by the college community. It complies with requirements for an effective and safe learning environment (Complies with workplace health & safety requirements) and encourages identification with the college and fosters a sense of belonging.

Students are required to wear their dress uniform (see below for description) on Wednesdays and for all formal occasions such as awards nights, other college or public functions and any other time outlined by the school. Students in Years 7 - 12 may wear the Everyday uniform (see below) on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Students involved in school sport, or representing the college in sporting activities, must wear the sports uniform.

Students are required to adhere to the Brisbane Bayside State College *Sun Safety Policy* situated on the school website which stipulates that they must wear a college uniform hat when in the sun.

The approved Everyday uniform, including hat or cap, must be worn for Physical Education lessons. For practical subjects, students are required to wear enclosed black leather shoes (E.g., Technology and Science). These can be brought to school in school bag.

The following expectations are part of our student dress code:

Make-up:

- Lipstick, eye make-up, false eyelashes, false/acrylic fingernails and coloured nail polish are NOT part of the student dress code. Students will be asked to remove these immediately or in an agreed timeline with the Year Level Coordinator or DP.

Jewellery:

- The only acceptable jewellery to be worn is a watch; 2 plain small sleepers (less than 10c coin) or studs per ear;
- Necklaces must be out of sight under shirts/blouses. No bracelets, bands or rings.
- Any facial piercings must be clear plastic and be small and inconspicuous (<3mm). Any large facial piercings must be removed. Stretchers must be removed.

Presentation:

- The Dress uniform and Everyday uniform cannot be worn together, with the exception of the tracksuit jacket and tracksuit pants, which may be worn as part of the formal uniform.
- Students who present out of uniform, will be offered a uniform to wear for the day. Students who refuse to wear the school uniform will have their parents contacted and may be sent home for being out of uniform.
- Hair is to be a natural hair colour. Hair must be neat and tidy. Long hair MUST be tied back for practical lessons.
- Hair accessories (e.g., ribbons, scrunchies and head bands), and headwear (religious reasons), must be white, black or navy.

Winter Uniform:

- Tracksuit pants/ Navy pants may be worn with everyday polo and the formal shirt.
- Non-college jumpers are to be worn underneath the college uniform out of sight.
- A plain white undershirt may be worn under the school shirt.
- Extraneous items of clothing (e.g., scarves, beanies) are NOT acceptable.

Any items of religious or cultural significance outside the specified *Student Dress Code* must be negotiated with, and approved by, College Administration.

The only place that sells the required College uniform is the P & C uniform shop located on the College grounds.

Students who do not wear the uniform correctly, incur uniform breaches or wear the incorrect uniform will be issued a detention as a consequence. Continuation of uniform breaches will possibly result in afterschool detentions/ suspensions.

Shorts: See image.

Shirt: See image.

Socks: Plain white above ankle.

Hat: BBSC hat or cap.

Tracksuit: Jacket and tracksuit pants (optional).

Senior Jersey: Year 12 only (optional).

Hats: Only BBSC Hats available at the school uniform shop

Shoes: Lace up (or Velcro fastening if required) sport shoes (No canvas)

Shoes: Black impervious full covered leather lace-up (or Velcro fastening if required). (see image)

Jumper: Purple, v-neck pullover; College navy zip front jacket; purple embroidered tracksuit jacket.

College Blazer: Years 11 and 12 only (optional).
