Thank you for your interest in Brisbane Bayside State College's Senior Schooling Scholarship.

Scholarships are open to all students in years 10, 11 and 12 who can demonstrate strength and aptitude in one of the following areas:

- Academic
- Sports
- Arts
- Community

The scholarship value is determined each year to cover the cost of the Student Resource Scheme (SRS), in line with the junior scholarship amount in years 7-10. The scholarship funding can be used at the discretion of the parent/guardian for any school related expenditure. Only one scholarship will be awarded per student, and students must apply for the scholarship each school year.

Students awarded a scholarship will have their progress reviewed in June/July. Students awarded a scholarship must continue to meet the behavioural and academic effort results as outlined in the scholarship criteria and expectations.
